Via Steamboat Blvd:

Take Steamboat Blvd north to Fish Creek Falls Road, then continue straight (Steamboat Blvd turns into Huckleberry at Fish Creek Falls Road). Continue on Huckleberry Lane approximately 1/3 miles (past Alexander Way , Upper Huckleberry and the private road signs). Our house is a cream colored stucco on the right. Parking will be across the drive (on the left) by the barn and in the horse pasture. Look for the signs!

Via Fish Creek Falls Road from 3rd Street:

Drive up Fish Creek Falls Road, turn Left on Huckleberry Lane (Steamboat Blvd is on the right at Huckleberry Lane). Continue on Huckleberry Lane approximately 1/3 miles (past Alexander Way, Upper Huckleberry and the private road signs). Our house is a cream colored stucco on the right. MONDAY HIKING SCHEDULE OTHG SUMMER 2019 MEET AT SAFEWAY AT 8:30am

Note the new summer hours. Check the website for the scheduled hikes. ssothg.org. The listed hikes are suggestions only. There are no designated hike leaders but someone usually steps up and offers to act as leader. Full hike descriptions can be found in Hiking the Boat II by Diane White-Crane.

July 1, Uranium Mine, about 5 miles RT with 800' +/- elevation gain

July 8, Fish Creek Falls, about 8 miles RT with 1,700' +/- elevation gain

July 15, Rabbit Ears, 6 miles RT, 9,604' to 10,654' +/- Should be a good wildflower walk

July 22, Prospector Trail, Hahns Peak area, 7 miles RT, 8,500' to 9,400' +/- Nice views from the ridge.

July 29, Hinman Lake and view, about 4.75 miles each way, 7,800', lake 8,195'
