ROAD BIKE RIDES - TUES/THURS 9:00AM

The regularly scheduled road rides begin at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays, weather permitting. We will be meeting at River Creek Park and riding a route that is agreed by the group. No one will be dropped on these rides. We may well split into multiple groups in order to accommodate different interests and capabilities.

In addition to the Thursday rides, we will be offering informal social rides on each Tuesday. The planned rides will leave from River Creek Park or may involve transporting our bikes to a different starting point.

GRAVEL BIKE RIDES - FRIDAYS 8:30 AM

The gravel road rides return in June! Dave Kinnear will be organizing a group that will head out to some of the scenic back roads in Routt County for a fun ride. We will meet at **River Creek Park**, **8:30 am** on Friday mornings. With bikes on our vehicles, we will drive out to our starting point. Expect a ride of 15-30 miles. The early-season rides will be shorter. Many of the routes are out and back, so riders can easily turn around if they get tired. No one will be dropped.

Gravel road riders use mountain bikes, gravel bikes and e-bike versions of both. All are welcome. Your bike should have a tire width of at least 32 mm.

As in the past, we will be starting out slowly and the hikes will gradually increase in length and difficulty as the summer progresses. We are publishing one month of hikes at a time. Please double check the calendar https://www.ssothg.org/events and website for possible changes.

The meeting place will be the Safeway parking lot, Creekside. Please be there 10 minutes before the start time as we tend to leave promptly. The listed June hikes are suggestions only. There are no designated leaders, but someone usually steps up and offers to act as leader. Full hike descriptions (shown by page number) can be found in *Hiking the Boat by* Diane White-Crane.

June hikes will be leaving from Safeway at **9:00 am** – we will carpool or caravan to the hike site.

June 7 Mad Creek Trail (P.60-63) (access 5.5 mi. N on RC-129) About 1.5 miles each way. We hike to the bridge, then turn around and visit the Forest Service Guardhouse on the way back. Starting elevation is 6,763' and we go to 7,200'±

<u>June 14 Uranium Mine</u> (P.47-48) (access via Fish Creek Falls parking lot) 1.5 miles each way. RT ± starting at 6,700' and going to 8,000'±

<u>June 21 Strawberry Park Hot Springs Trail</u> (P.66-67) (access 5.5mi. N on RC-129-Mad Creek parking lot) 3 miles each way. Starting at 6,700' and going to 7,800'±

June 28 Bear Creek Trail (Lower Bear) (P.58-60) (access


